
*36" and 42" high wall cabinets will have (3) adjustable shelves, (12) shelf rests and (3) hinges


IMPORTANT NOTES:

Before you start assembly, inspect all panels and hardware to ensure you have everything needed. In addition to the tan RTA Connector Brackets supplied, we recommend you run a bead of white wood glue into each groove as you assemble, to create the strongest cabinet. We also recommend laying the panels on some cardboard to protect the finish when assembling.













Ensure the central locking hole on the plate is located away from the edge of the panel




Run a bead of wood glue in the horizontal grooves in the back of Frame (A) and End Panels (C). Then slide the Fixed Shelves (D) completely into the grooves.











Apply beads of wood glue to the recesses along the back edges of the End Panels (C) and in the horizontal grooves in Back Panel (B). Carefully install Back Panel (B) so that the panels align and the L-Brackets & Connector Plates snap together. Ensure the Fixed Shelves (D) are seated fully in grooves in the Back Panel (B) and End Panels (C).














Turn the cabinet over again and insert (4) #6 x 1" Flat Head screws thru holes in Back Panel (B). Tighten securely into Fixed Shelves (D).
